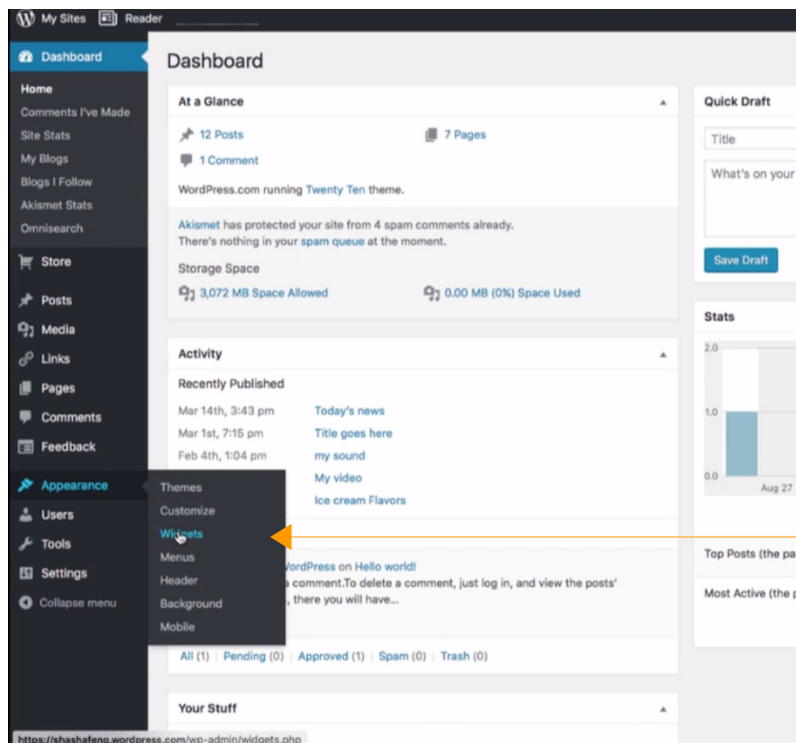

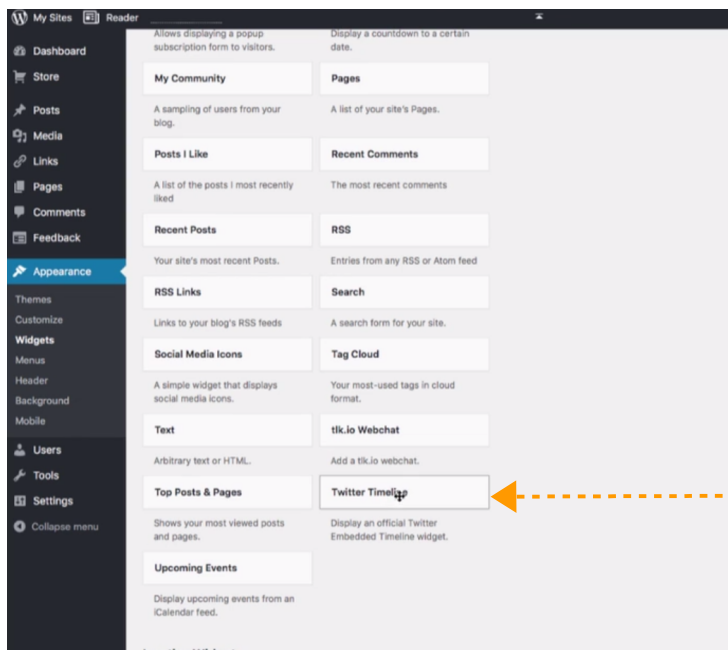

This sidebar on your website is called the widgets area.



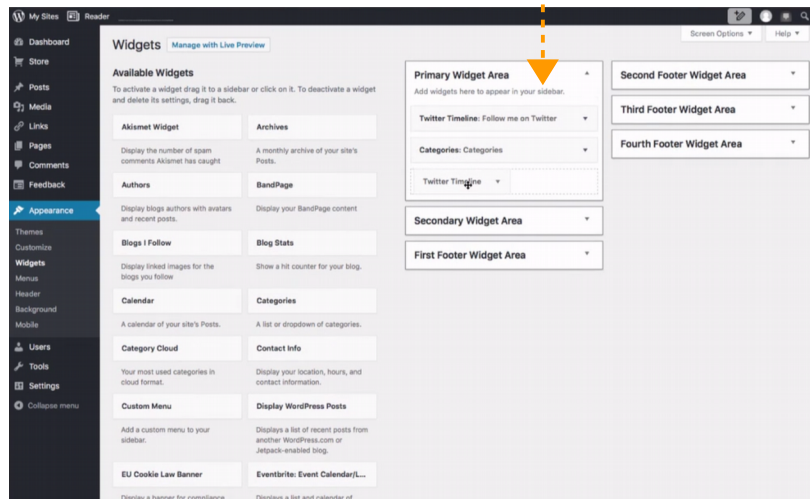
To add to your widgets area go to your administrations panel and go to *Appearance > Widgets*



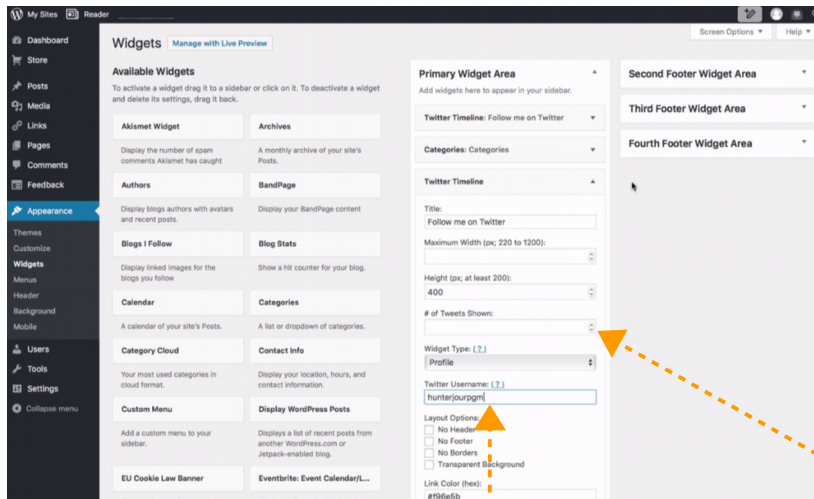
On this page you will see all the available widgets. For example, we are going to add the twitter timeline to our sidebar.

Primary Widget Area



Drag and drop the *twitter timeline* into the primary widget area.

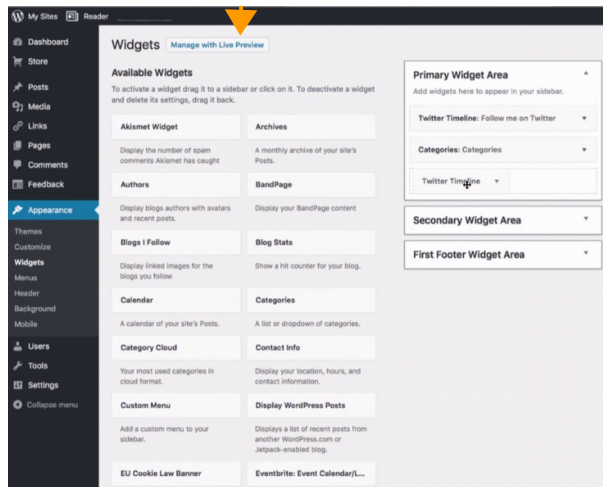


Click on the *twitter timeline* tab. Add your twitter username or hashtag and the number of tweets you want to show on your website. Once you're done click save. Refresh your website and you should see your *twitter timeline*.

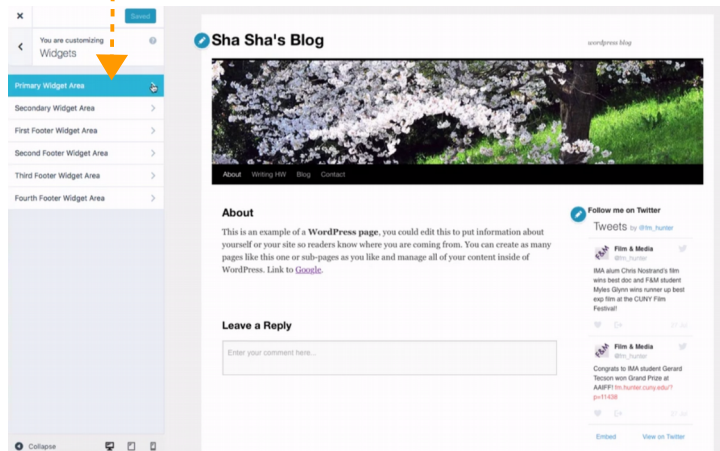

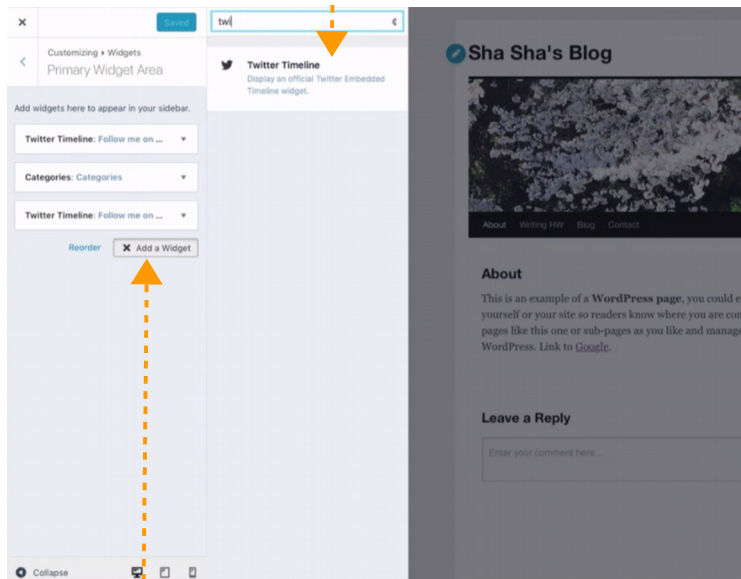
If on the widgets area you do not see the *twitter timeline* available, click on *manage with live preview*.
