

Computer Security

Be aware: some applications for downloading music, movies and other files actually turn your computer into a server, allowing it to be used for distributing copyrighted material.

The University's stance on this issue is simple: downloading copyrighted material without permission is illegal, and you should not do it. You should also not use your computer to distribute copyrighted material without the permission of the copyright holder.

Web Content

If any student uploads "inappropriate material" it will be removed from department web servers immediately.

Creating a Good Password

You will be prompted to change your default password immediately when you first login.

How can I create a good password?

- Passwords must be 7 or more characters in length

Example of a good password:

You can use a phrase to generate a password: Take the phrase "I Love To Eat Hotdogs Everyday". Example: il2ehded

Creating Files and Folders

When creating File and Folders

- Do Not Use Spaces (Whitef HW 21.doc)
- Do not use Dashes or Hyphens (whitef/profect-3.jpg)
- Do not make file name longer than 16 Characters (myhomework09-whitef.pdf)

Example of Good File Names

- whitef_HM21.doc
- Whitefproject.jpg
- homework3.pdf

Example of Good Folder Names.

- Project21
- Whitef_docs
- mydownloads7

Using AFP (Mac only)

- Finder→Go→Connect to Server
